TYPICAL JOB DUTIES

The SR-PM is a non-firefighter position that provides ALS care and transport of patients as part of the inter-facility transport service agreement with Jefferson Healthcare. In addition to inter-facility transports, an SR-PM may deliver expanded role emergency medical services such as emergency incident rehabilitation, mobile integrated healthcare, and injury reduction/prevention programs.

The SR-PM is required to perform conscientiously, proficiently and independently at any and all assignments and duties. The SR-PM is responsible for recognizing the importance placed on activities by the public and for tactful and respectful treatment of citizens. **APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS** Employees must have a diploma or GED certificate and be 18 years of age.

Possess and maintain a valid Washington State Paramedic or National Registry Certification. Possess and maintain a current PALS

and ACLS Certification.

Possess a valid WA State Driver's License, and, as required, with a driving record free of any significant moving violations as determined by EJFR. Maintain insurability to drive/ operate a motor vehicle in Washington State.

Ability to pass a Background Check with no fail criteria.
